- **English classes** are open to **BOTH** Huntseat and Saddleseat horses.
- Classes open to all horses and ponies.
- Every horse on the grounds **MUST** have a **CURRENT** negative coggins. Coggins will be checked upon arrival and must be posted on stall door or at trailer (for haul-ins).
- **No entries will be accepted without an open check or payment.**
- Arabian classes open to pure & part-breeds.
- A "Novice" Rider or Horse is one having won 5 or fewer 1st places in any class in any division at any show prior to 1/1/2008. **Exceptions:** halter, 10 & Under, and classes in which there were only one entry.
- **FORMAL** show attire not required; however, appropriate hat (no ball caps) & boots with heel are required. Riding helmets allowed all classes.
- "Scratches" must be submitted on a "Scratch" form **at least 3 classes in advance** or the entry fee will be charged for the class!
- To be eligible for the 75% Payback & Jackpot classes Horse/Rider combination must show in at least one other class in that division prior to the Payback or Jackpot class.
- **Jackpot classes** are held on Sunday only. Entire purse goes to the winner.
- Each day will count as a separate show for year end points (TWhA only)
- Points from this show accepted by most Breed associated Open Show Programs including.

Prizes & Awards

- **1st place** in novice and youth classes will receive a trophy; all other classes will receive **CASH!** or prizes.
- **High Point Circuit Awards** will be given to the high point **Champion** and **Reserve** in the following divisions: **Hunt Seat, Saddle Seat & Western for both Youth & Adult divisions.** Based on the 2 day total. Must show both days to qualify.

Special Events

- ****New Rules - Team Competition:** Teams to consist of 2 exhibitors of ANY age. No longer limited to only youth. Team Entry Fee of \$30/team. At the end of Sunday's show the points will be added and the 1st and 2nd place teams will get special awards. Must show both days to qualify. See website for more details.
- A **"Down East" Pig Pickin'** will be catered Saturday night after the show. Tickets available in the office.
- **Complimentary** coffee, juice and donuts will be provided each morning.
- **An informal Exhibitor's Supper** will be provided free of charge on Friday night around 6:00. We'll supply homemade soup and sandwiches, potluck dishes or deserts are welcome. First come, first serve!
- **Due to time constraints we will not be holding a dog show this year.**

Pre-Entry:

- Pre-entries save time for both office staff and exhibitors. To encourage pre-entries we will give a **\$5/horse rebate** to all entries received by Sept. 15th.
- An open check (or payment) must accompany all entries.
- All rebates will be given at the show office.
- Pre-entry is **RISK FREE!** You can still add/scratch classes at the show. If you can't attend simply let us know before the show begins and refunds will be given in full, less a \$10 office charge.
- You may choose to enter using our online form or by mailing in an entry form. Blank entry forms are available on our web site or by calling (252) 753-8069.

Stalls:

- Please reserve your stalls in advance if possible.
- Pre-Payment for stalls is not required.
- Stalls are **\$50** for the weekend. Please let us know who you'd like to be stalled with.
- Please let us know if you will be arriving very early or very late so we can make arrangements for your stalls and shavings to be available.

Other Fees & Information

- A grounds fee of **\$10/day** per horse will be charged for anyone not using a stall.
- Shavings will be **\$7.00/bag**. Pre-pay for them and they will be waiting in your stalls.
- Camper/trailer hookups are **\$50/weekend**. Plugging trailers or campers into the barns is prohibited!
- Show grounds open Friday at 10:00 am. Stalls, shavings and the arena will be available at this time. Stalls must be vacated by noon Monday.
- Show Office will open no later than 3:00 p.m. on Friday and 7:00 a.m. Saturday & Sunday. Closing times TBA.
- There will be a **\$50** fee for all returned checks!

In order to ensure that everyone has a safe and enjoyable time we ask you to abide by these rules:

- **Alcoholic Beverages Prohibited.**
- Any motorized vehicle to be operated by licensed drivers **ONLY**.
- No ATV's or 4 Wheelers allowed on the grounds.
- No children will be unsupervised in the arenas. Absolutely no playing allowed near the arenas!
- All dogs on the grounds must be on a leash and controlled at all times. No dogs in the arenas. Vaccination records must be made available upon request.

Directions

The Eastern Ag Center is conveniently located off of Hwy 64. It is only about a 2 hour drive on an all 4-lane highway from Raleigh.

From Raleigh or Interstate 95, take 64 EAST to Williamston. Take Exit 512. It is well marked as the Ag Center Exit. At the Exit stop sign, turn left. Go 3/4 mile and the Ag. Center will be on your right. Look for the large lighted sign and lots of white fence.
